- ❑ Diagnosed with AIDS at age 13
- ❑ Internationally known for his fight against discrimination

Who was Ryan White?



- ❑ He passed away at the age of 18 on April 8, 1990
- ❑ Present Day: his mother still travels around the world telling recount of his struggle, pain, triumph

The Legacy of Ryan White



- ❑ After his passing the bill that bears his name was passed:
The Ryan White Care Act
- ❑ The act was reauthorized in 1996, 2000, 2006, 2009
- ❑ In 2006 renamed:
Ryan White HIV/AIDS Program
