Practice Gap/Educational Need

Practice Gap: Reliable resources are needed to help facilitate locating near-real-time available treatment options (including medication-assisted treatment) for women with substance use disorder/opioid use disorder (SUD/OUD) at their moment of readiness.

Educational Need: FindHelpNowKY.org is the only near-real-time SUD/OUD treatment availability locator in Kentucky. Healthcare providers can become knowledgeable about how to quickly locate near-real-time SUD/OUD treatment availability options by implementing the treatment locator tool into their daily clinical practices and workflows.










UPDATING TREATMENT SLOTS

 - Outpatient updates = 94 days




List multiple treatment types






Clients locate available near-real-time treatment options using matching search criteria




